## **ORDINANCE 8**

AN ORDNANCE TO RESTRAIN PERSONS FROM GATHERING IN FRONT OF PUBLIC PLACES, CHURCHES, ETC., AND ACTING IN A DISORDERLY MANNER

The City Council of Minnesota City do ordain as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. It shall he unlawful for any person or persons to congregate or loiter in front of any church or public building, or disturb such meeting by shouting or unseemly conduct.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. It shall be the duty of the city Marshall or other officer to arrest all persons engaged in such unseemly and unlawful conduct.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. All persons so arrested, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) and not to exceed twenty- five dollars (\$25.00) and costs, and shall be imprisoned in jail until such fine and costs of suit are paid, which imprisonment shall not exceed ninety days.
