

## ORDINANCE 18

### AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PUBLIC DANCES.

The City Council of Minnesota City does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage and publication of this Ordinance no person, firm or corporation shall hold, conduct or operate a public dance in the City of Minnesota City unless there has been issued to such person, firm or corporation by the city council of the City of Minnesota City a permit to so hold, conduct and operate such public dance.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to hold, conduct or operate a public dance within the City of Minnesota City shall file with the Clerk of the city council a written application for a permit therefor pursuant to the terms of Minnesota Statutes Annotated. Sections 617.42 through 617.54; and such application shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount hereinafter set forth.

SECTION 3. The permit fee shall be the sum of One Dollar for each twenty-four hour period from 12:00 noon for which it is desired that the public dance be permitted.

SECTION 4. The annual permit fee shall be the sum of Sixty Dollars payable semi-annually payable Thirty Dollars on July 1st and Thirty Dollars on January 2nd of each year which fee shall permit the holding, conduction and operation of a public dance for the period from July 1st to June 30th of the following year; provided, however, that the permit fee for the period from the effective date of this ordinance until July 1, 1951, for any permit for a period in excess of forty-eight hours, shall be the sum of Two and 50/100 (\$2.50) Dollars for any thirty- one day period, or fraction thereof.

SECTION 5. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk to issue a permit to such applicant when the city council has approved the application

SECTION 6. Nothing herein shall be construed to enlarge the period of time within which public dances may be held pursuant to the terms of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 617.42 through 617.54, or in any other way exceed the limitations imposed upon the holding, conduction and operation of public dances.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
