

ORDINANCE 37

(Published Date Tuesday, February 14, 1967)

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AND THE PARKING DURING SNOW REMOVAL

The City of Minnesota City ordains:

Section 1.

Article 1. As used herein the term (a) "vehicle" shall mean every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway and (b) "street" shall mean any street, avenue, place, drive, or any other public way in the City of Minnesota City.

Article 2. No person shall park a vehicle or permit it to stand upon any street or highway in the City of Minnesota City for more than 48 consecutive hours at any time except in an emergency or otherwise designated on signs erected and installed.

Section 2

Article 1. No person, except a physician on an emergency call, shall park or leave a vehicle on any street when snow is falling or has fallen in the past 24 hours.

Article 2. No person shall park any vehicle, blocking any sidewalk, crosswalk or drive.

Article 3. Parking may be resumed on streets as soon as the snow has been removed from streets, except as may be otherwise restricted by Ordinance.

Article 4. Any vehicles left parked contrary to this ordinance will be tagged and towed away at the owner's expense.

Article 5. The City of Minnesota City shall not be responsible for any damage to such vehicles removed in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Article 6. Penalty. Persons, firms, or corporations violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Fifty and no/100 dollars (\$50), or in default thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not to exceed thirty days together with the costs of prosecution in any case.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
