

Ordinance No. 10

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF LEGALIZED MALT  
BEVERAGES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MINNESOTA CITY

The Village Council do ordain as follows.

SECTION 1.

Legalized malt beverages containing less than one half of one percent alcohol by volume are exempted from the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 2.

No person shall give, barter, sell, or dispose of any legalized malt beverages within the Village of Minnesota City between the hours of twelve O'clock midnight and Five O'clock AM.

SECTION 3.

Any person violation the provisions of section 2 of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less Twenty Five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County jail for not less than thirty nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect at 12:01 AM Apr, 7, 1933 and shall remain in force until repealed or otherwise annulled.
