A motion was made by Joe Pellowski and seconded by Angie Bohnstengel to approve the building permit for 160 Mill Street for an Interior remodel for 1 residential unit. All voted in favor; motion passed.

Dave McCorquodale Senior approached the council with concerns of lowering the weight limit on Wenonah road to 5 tons. He is worried that his bus company will have to shut down as he won't have access to his business. He is asking the council to reconsider and keep the road at 7 tons. The part of the road that is owned by the city is only approximately one block as the city only owns up to the tracks. Rollingstone Township owns Wenonah Road on the other side of the tracks and will be discussing how many tons they will set the weight limit to. The council will probably match whatever the township decides to do. Council is trying to preserve the condition of the road as there are no taxpayers on the road so it is hard to justify maintenance on it. Council will readdress after the township decides.

A motion was made by Joe Pellowski and seconded by Angie Bohnstengel to approve the voided check #6474 due to printing error. All voted in favor; motion passed.
