

MINNESOTA CITY ORDINANCE NO. 21

(Publishing Date Wednesday, November 21, 1951.)

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION AND LICENSING OF CABARETS LOCATED WITH IN THE VILLAGE OF MINNESOTA CITY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Minnesota City does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. A cabaret, for the purposes of this ordinance, is defined as a place to which the general public is invited and admitted and where food and either or both intoxication and non-intoxication liquors are sold and where orchestral or other music and entertainments and amusements are provided with or without charge, and where the patrons are permitted to participate in the entertainments and amusements.

SECTION III. The word "person" as used in this ordinance shall include individuals, partnerships, corporations and associations.

SECTION III. No person, firm or corporation shall hereafter keep, maintain, conduct or operate a cabaret as herein defined without first having obtained a license therefor as herein provided.

SECTION IV. Any person desiring to procure a cabaret license shall file application therefor with the Village Council which said application shall contain the name and place of residence of the applicant, and the exact location of the premises upon which the applicant proposes to operate said cabaret. Before filing such application the applicant shall pay to the Village Clerk the full semi-annual license fee as herein provided. It shall be the duty of the Village Clerk to issue a permit to such applicant when the Village Council has approved the application.

SECTION V. That the fee for a cabaret license as herein defined shall be the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each half year and such licenses issued hereunder shall expire on the 30th day of June and the 31st day of December of each year.

SECTION VI. No cabaret license issued hereunder shall be transferable either as to location or as to licensee without the permission of the Village Council secured in advance.

SECTION VII. The cabaret license as herein provided shall not be lieu of any other license, and shall be in addition to any other license required by the ordinances of the Village of Minnesota City, except that the holder of a cabaret license as herein provided shall not be required to have or obtain a license for dancing as provided by ordinance.

SECTION VIII. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). or by imprisonment not to exceed ten (10) days, or both.

SECTION IX. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after December 31, 1951.

SECTION X. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
